

Thanks to recent acquisitions, Quick Group has expanded its product portfolio, also including complex components for superyachts such as ladders, gangways and deck equipment, integrated control systems such as electronic diesel, electric and hybrid propulsion control systems, electronic steering systems with electro-hydraulic actuation, maneuvering systems (also assisted), position-holding systems, stability control systems and remote control and, finally, doors, portlights, hatches, cleats and steering wheels.
